Good afternoon Stephen, thank you for your email below.

Please note that following the serious and complex cyber-attack on SEPA in December 2020, some of our systems and services continue to be badly affected and will be for some time.

However, we have been able to assess your request for information and using our limited search facilities, we can now confirm the following information:-

- WML/XS/1100565 – issued on 15/02/2012 – still current and valid
- WML/XS/1130236 – issued on 05/11/2014 – still current and valid

If these were applied for online an email confirmation letter was emailed to the applicant, if they were applied for by paper application, a letter of confirmation was sent, either by email or by post. Either way SEPA did not keep a copy of this type of exemption on their Public Register. This type of exemption does not expire.

SEPA's Public Register remains impacted by the cyber-attack and we are rebuilding in phases. We are providing you with the best information we currently have available but cannot confirm it is complete or accurate. Any use you make of this information will be at your own risk.
